Take home messages from Wittgenstein for your community

Although our knowledge is compiled and sophisticated through human history, we don't have to know everything because it is already a huge amount of information thanks to wise people. Thus, we would like to discuss Wittgenstein thesis 7 shortly.

7. Whereof one cannot speak thereof one must be silent.

The contraposition of this is 7'. One must not be silent about whereof one can speak. Indeed, there are many curios topics that we don't have answers including the interpretation of God, immortality, the shortest path to realize the ideal world*, and so on. On the other hand, we have empirical (inductive reasoning) beliefs/proof such as physics can describe the world in a grand unified manner throughout mankind's history. Thus, there must be meaning to talk about something we don't know. It is also an implication of improvement, especially thesis 5-7, In general, we should talk about ethics, morals, and good/bad to improve.

7'. One must not be silent about whereof one can speak.

To solve all the problems in philosophy, he finished at 7 thesis. With all due respect, we are till curious that the 7 is the final thesis.

Here, we make Proposition A.

A. If all the problems in philosophy are solved, then Wittgenstein's approach finishes at 7.

Then, the Contraposition A' is

A'. If Wittgenstein finishes at 7, all the problems in philosophy are not solved.

It is an implication that we should keep trying to improve. It is making sense if we think Wittgenstein implied it beforehand. So, probably he knew about it.
